



Academic Calendar – Fall 2017

(Course offerings, dates, and times are subject to change.)

To qualify for tuition-free classes, students must register by noon, Saturday, August 12, 2017. Thereafter, a nominal fee of \$100 for one to all offered classes will apply. New students pay a one-time non-refundable \$25 application fee but do not pay a semester fee if registered by the deadline for tuition-free classes. Returning students pay a flat \$25 semester fee, which is due by the registration deadline. All students purchase their own text books, which are available on the internet or local bookstores. <p>BNT 305 - New Testament Book Study: I & II Peter and Jude (3 Credit Hours) Saturdays 9:00 – 11:40am Dr. Glenda Turner</p> <p><i>A detailed study of I & II Peter paying special attention to themes and how they are found in other biblical books. Students will also examine Peter's life, New Testament background and current scholarly publications and how the book of Jude aligns with Peter's writings.</i></p>	<p>BIB 115 - Bible Study Methods (3 Credit hours) Mondays 6:00 – 8:40pm Dr. Bill Mienert</p> <p><i>Emphasizes the inductive Bible study method and basic principles/resources of biblical interpretation and study. Students will learn how to research, summarize, distinguish between literal and figurative language and apply biblical truths to real life situations</i></p>
<p>COM 102 - Grammar and Composition (3 Credit hours) Tuesdays, 6:00-8:40 pm Ms. Renee Hansen</p> <p><i>Designed to strengthen skills in standard English grammar as well as to teach the process of writing formal college essays. Students will develop at least two short essays that follow APA guidelines and include thesis statements, an argument structure, and credible resources with citations.</i></p>	<p>BNT 101 – New Testament Survey I (3 Credit Hours) Thursdays, 6:00-8:40 pm Mr. Alan Shaw, Professor</p> <p><i>Part one of a two-part study which examines the background information of the twenty-seven books of the New Testament. Students will develop a deeper understanding to answer the “why, who and where” questions that may arise as they explore these familiar passages.</i></p>
